

Christie McGlashan Memorial Scholarship

HISTORY

This scholarship, in the name of Christie McGlashan, was created in her memory in 1992. Christie was a bright and talented U11 player with Semiahmoo Soccer Club who lost her life in a tragic car accident while on her way to soccer practice. Initially started as a single scholarship, Coastal FC has expanded the number of scholarships granted to include those graduating from the U18 program who meet the eligibility criteria below.

TO QUALIFY FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP, THE APPLICANT MUST:

- Have been a member in good standing for a minimum of five (5) consecutive years, with the last year being U18, with Coastal FC and/or its predecessor clubs.
 - Note: Exceptions will be made on a case-by-case basis by the Club's directors for special circumstances, for example: where the Club did not field a team at the U18 level of play appropriate to the applicant.
- Submit their letter application in accordance with the Application Procedure below.
- Attend a post-secondary education or training institution by April 1, within 12 months of the year of Application.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Applicants (not parents) are to provide a letter or email stating their eligibility for this bursary and a brief narrative describing their experience(s) with Coastal FC (and/or its predecessor club) and include it with the online application.

Letters should be sent to Shelley Chin schin@coastalfc.ca and should include a return mail and email address.

The application deadline is the end of the day on February 15 each year.

By submitting their application, the applicant agrees to publish their name to announce successful bursary applicants and provide anonymous excerpts from their application on the Club's website.



AWARD PROCEDURE:

Applicants will be contacted via return email regarding the success of their application and will be requested to attend the Club's annual Awards Night to receive their scholarship certificate.

PAYMENT PROCEDURE:

Once the successful applicant is enrolled at their post-secondary education or training institution, they will need to email a copy of their tuition receipt or equivalent confirmation of attendance to: Shelley Chin schin@coastalfc.ca

Once received, an e-transfer for \$350 will be issued by the Club within 4 weeks to the designated payee.

Scholarship payment eligibility will expire on April 1st of the following year of the application date.
