Fall Game Schedule

The Fall Game Schedule is completed. The schedule is available online on the club website. The time listed on the schedule is the kickoff time. You will have access to the field 30 minutes prior to your game. Games must start on time to avoid backing up throughout the day. Referees will be asked to start precisely on time and games that will start late will be cut short to maintain the schedule. Please ensure that your team is ready to play.

Turf Field Set Up

We will have staff on site to have fields prepared for 8:00am. This will allow teams to start promptly at 8:30am. There will be some transition assistance from coaches coming onto the field at certain points.

- The fields used for U5-U7 teams will be set up by Coastal FC staff in the BMO Coastal Soccer Centre (nets and cones for fields)
- Coastal FC staff will be also setting up the U8-U10 fields that will be located on SSAP 8 and SSAP 9.

- Coastal FC staff will come and put away the goals and cones at the completion of the U10 games. Please assist this process by:
 - Ensuring that the goals are moved near the entry gates
 - Stack the cones (please DO NOT take cones with you. If we lose the cones they will no longer be provided at set up)
- U11-U18 will play on full fields using the existing markings (8v8 for U11-U12 and full field for U13 - U18

Morgan Creek and Dufferin Park Set Up

Goals and nets are in place at Morgan Creek and Dufferin Park. Goals will need to be moved into place at the beginning of the day on Saturday and pushed back to the fence after the final game on Sunday. Corner flags are not required for Spring soccer and there is no need to pick them up.

Clarification of retreat line (half way) rule U5-U7:

The retreat line is initiated when the ball has gone out for a goal kick. All opposing players will 'retreat' to half field and cannot pursue the ball until:


- The ball is received by a teammate OR,
- The ball travels over the retreat line OR,
- The ball leaves the field of play

If preferred, teams are always able to play quickly; the ball would be in play as soon as it leaves the penalty area regardless of the opposing team's position.



Encroachment of retreat line:

If the defending team encroaches across the retreat line before an opposition player touches the ball then the referee stops play and issues a re-take of the goal kick. If the opposing team repeatedly infringes the retreat line, an indirect free kick shall be awarded from the place where the offence occurred for not respecting the restart.



Clarification of retreat line (3/4 mark) rule U9-U18:

The retreat line is initiated when the ball has gone out for a goal kick. All opposing players will 'retreat' to the markers indicating the retreat line and cannot pursue the ball until:

- The ball is received by a teammate OR
- The ball travels over the retreat line OR,
- The ball leaves the field of play



Encroachment of the retreat line:


If the defending team encroaches across the retreat line before an opposition player touches the ball then the referee stops play and issues a re-take of the goal kick.

If the opposing team repeatedly infringes the retreat line, an indirect free kick shall be awarded from the place where the offence occurred for not respecting the restart.

Making the Right Decision:

Teams are always able to play quickly; the ball would be in play as soon as it leaves the penalty area regardless of the opposing team's position.

At times the correct decision is a quick or a long pass, players need to recognize the positions of the opposing team and act accordingly. If there is the opportunity to play quickly to create a counter attack or find a player in the middle third of the field - it should be encouraged!
